CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

FARMERS IRRIGATION DISTRICT
1985 COUNTRY CLUB ROAD
HOOD RIVER, OREGON 97031

confirms the right to use the waters of RAINY CREEK, WITH AN DEFICIENCY TO BE MADE UP FROM GATE CREEK, CABIN CREEK, DITCH CREEK AND DEADPOINT CREEK, UPPER AND LOWER GREENPOINT RESERVOIRS CONSTRUCTED UNDER PERMIT R-698, tributaries of HOOD RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 149.5 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 51189. The date of priority is APRIL 27, 1989. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 1.87 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

RAINEY CREEK - NE 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 25, T 2 N, R 8 E, W.M.; 600 FEET SOUTH AND 1150 FEET WEST FROM THE E 1/4 CORNER, SECTION 25;

GATE CREEK - NE 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 30, T 2 N, R 9 E, W.M.; 940 FEET SOUTH AND 600 FEET WEST FROM THE C 1/4 CORNER, SECTION 3;

CABIN CREEK - NW 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 32, T 2 N, R 9 E, W.M.; 170 FEET SOUTH AND 800 FEET EAST FROM THE N 1/4 CORNER, SECTION 34;

UPPER GREENPOINT RESERVOIR - NW 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 22, T 2 N, R 9 E, W.M.; 2800 FEET SOUTH AND 1950 FEET WEST FROM NE CORNER, SECTION 22;

LOWER GREENPOINT RESERVOIR - SE 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 15, T 2 N, R 9 E, W.M.; 50 FEET NORTH AND 850 FEET WEST FROM NE CORNER, SECTION 22;

DITCH CREEK - SE 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 14, T 2 N, R 9 E, W.M.; 1900 FEET SOUTH AND 1080 FEET WEST FROM E 1/4 CORNER, SECTION 14;

DEADPOINT CREEK - LOT 4 (NW 1/4 NW 1/4), SECTION 2, T 1 N, R 9 E, W.M.; 150 FEET SOUTH AND 1200 FEET EAST FROM NW CORNER, SECTION 2.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:


Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this right may result in action including, but not limited to restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the right.

This right is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
